Medicaid pays for care management services for those who are eligible. It does not cost you anything to enroll.

What if I am a member of a Managed Care Organization?

Members of Medicaid Managed Care Organizations are eligible to receive Health Home Care Management. Once you complete the application and consent form, CNYHHN will contact your Managed Care Organization to let them know.
